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Will Uzbekistan fund a 250-megawatt solar photovoltaic plant?

Tashkent,Uzbekistan,May 21,2024 -- The World Bank Group,Abu Dhabi Future Energy Company PJSC (Masdar),and the Government of Uzbekistan have signed a financial package to fund a 250-megawatt (MW) solar photovoltaic plantwith a 63-MW battery energy storage system (BESS).

Who will sell electricity to in Uzbekistan?

The project company is committed to selling electricity to the state-owned National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan JSCunder a 25-year Power Purchase Agreement for the project,including a 10-year operating term for the BESS component,signed by these two entities.

How can Uzbekistan meet its energy needs?

Uzbekistan is capable of meeting its energy needs from its own energy resources. Uzbekistan owns a significant part of the installed capacity of the united power system of Central Asia.

What is the energy sector like in Uzbekistan?

In Uzbekistan,the energy sector is concentrated in the hands of two monopolies,Uzbekenergo and Uzbekneftegaz,with mineral resources and rare-earth minerals concentrated at metallurgy plants,which the government intends to upgrade through a number of sponsored programmes,and with the active assistance of foreign contractors and suppliers.
