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Converting between kW and kWh is straightforward: $\text{kWh} = \text{kW} \times \text{hours}$. Example: A 5 kW battery inverter running for 3 hours delivers: $5 \text{ kW} \times 3 \text{ hours} = 15 \text{ kWh}$ of energy. Reverse ...
